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### **Shawano County Human Services Campus** **Resealing of Asphalt W7327 Anderson Ave.** *Specifications to include in bid proposal*

- Clean blacktop surface free of dirt, debris prior to sealing.
- Clean out cracked areas.
- Clean and pretreat all oil spots.
- Trim back lawn around edges to make them straight.
- Heat lance vegetation as needed on all parts of lot.
- Fill and band all cracks with fed spec 3405 hot rubberized crack filler.
- Apply commercial grade coal tar or asphalt emulsion latex modified sealer to asphalt surface.
- Restripe back to existing design to include: The use of DOT spec. latex traffic paint to do line stripes, chevrons, handicap markings, walking paths.
- Minimum Completion time of 2 days to be done on a Saturday-Sunday.
- Contractor is responsible to pay and obtain all permits concerning the project.
- Contractor is responsible for all measurements, calculations, tools, materials and cleanup.
- Contractor is required to provide proof of insurance and liability in their bid.
