

**ORDINANCE NO. 6-11**

**AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 4-98 TO INCLUDE AN INITIAL ALARM SYSTEM PERMIT FEE OF \$35.00 AND ANNUAL RENEWAL OF \$20.00.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 4-98, known as the Alarm Ordinance, states that no alarm system shall be installed or be in place on any property or in any building unless the property owner, or alarm system operator, has been issued a permit by the Shawano County Sheriff's Department; and

**WHEREAS**, currently, there is no charge to obtain an alarm system permit; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to offset the costs associated with issuing alarm system permits and investigating alarms, a permit fee could be charged to all alarm system owners; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Safety Committee is recommending that all alarm system owners pay an initial alarm system permit fee of \$35.00 and an alarm system permit annual renewal fee of \$20.00.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SHAWANO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS** in session this 16<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2011, that Ordinance No. 4-98 be amended to include an initial alarm system permit fee of \$35.00 and an annual alarm system permit renewal fee of \$20.00.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the initial alarm permit fee shall not apply to any person or entity having an alarm system in place prior to the effective date of this amendment, but the \$20 renewal fee shall apply as set forth herein.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this amendment shall become effective on January 1, 2012, after passage and publication.
