Meeting was called to order by Chairman Zwirschitz.

**MOMENT OF SILENCE AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Zwirschitz requested a moment of silence and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

**MOTION TO DEVIATE FROM THE ORDER OF THE AGENDA:** Motion by Bolin, seconded by Ferfecki, to deviate from the Agenda should it become necessary. All in favor and motion carried.

**MINUTES APPROVAL:** Motion by Miller, seconded by Zeinert, to approve the May 3 and 25, 2017 minutes. All in favor and motion carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Richard Stadelman asked that the Committee take the Townships into consideration when discussing the County Hazmat Team. He stated that the Townships have put money towards this team.

**MONTHLY BILLS AND VOUCHERS:** Motion by Bolin, seconded by Zeinert, to approve the bills and vouchers as presented. All in favor and motion carried. The signed list can be viewed at the Finance Department.

**MONTHLY REPORT OF ACTIVITIES:** Coroner Westfahl reported 23 calls for the month of May where the Coroner was needed. Motion by Ferfecki, seconded by Miller, to approve the report. All in favor and motion carried.

## **EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT – Natalie Easterday**

**MONTHLY REPORT OF ACTIVITIES:** Natalie gave the Committee a written report. Motion by Zeinert, seconded by Miller, to approve the report. All in favor and motion carried.

**DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON DISPOSAL OF PORTA COUNT PRO EQUIPMENT:** The Fire Association expressed interest in obtaining this equipment from the County. Public Property asked that the Fire Association make an offer to the County to purchase the Porta Count Pro.

**DISCUSSION ON THE SHAWANO COUNTY HAZARDOUS MATERIAL TEAM:** A special meeting needs to be scheduled for the Committee and Hazmat members to discuss options for the Hazardous Material Team. Easterday explained that the Hazmat Team can be managed by the Fire Departments and the County can still apply for grant funding to provide to the team. The meeting will be on June 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm at the Fellman Center.

## **LAW ENFORCEMENT**

**APPROVE OUT-OF-STATE TRAINING FOR DETECTIVE CHRIS GAMM:** Detective Gamm would like to attend training this month in Nevada to be certified in cell phone examination. Internet Crimes Against Children will be reimbursing for all costs associated with this training. Motion by Zeinert, seconded by Bolin, to approve the out-of-state training for Detective Chris Gamm. All in favor and motion carried.

**RESOLUTION: TO IMPLEMENT A TREATMENT COURT FOR DRUG OFFENDERS COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS A "DRUG COURT" IN SHAWANO COUNTY:** Frost and Kane explained the concept of Drug Court to the Committee. Individuals would be court ordered for treatment administered through Human Services. Human Services will need to add a position in order to monitor and track the requirements for these individuals. Motion made by Ferfecki, seconded by Bolin, to approve the resolution as presented. All in favor and motion carried.

**RESOLUTION: TO APPROVE FUNDING AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW SHAWANO COUNTY EVIDENCE STORAGE FACILITY:** The resolution was provided to the Committee with all the details already discussed at the last joint meeting with Public Property. Motion by Zwirschitz, seconded by Ferfecki, to approve the resolution as presented. All in favor and motion carried.

**JAIL ADMINISTRATOR COMMENTS:** Report provided to the Committee. Motion by Zeinert, seconded by Bolin, to approve the report as presented. All in favor and motion carried.

**SHERIFF COMMENT:** Bieber advised that an eligibility list will be started for Correctional Officers.

Deputies are continuing traffic enforcement efforts on the major roadways in the County.

**COMMITTEE COMMENTS:** The Committee would like the meeting on June 14<sup>th</sup> on the Hazmat Team to be discussion only. Possible action would take place in the regular July Public Safety meeting.
